

## Safety Procedures

1. Following any contact of body areas with blood or infectious materials, workers and volunteers must wash their hands and any other exposed skin with soap and water.
2. During procedures involving blood or other infectious materials, minimize splashing, spraying, or other actions generating droplets of these materials.
3. Cleaning solution will be 1 to 10 Clorox solution
4. Diaper change and potty
  - a. Wash your hands and child's hands after each diaper change. If child is an infant, you may wipe child's hands with a wipe.
  - b. Wipe down changing table with cleaning solution after each diaper change.
5. Cuts and scrapes
  - a. Use latex gloves when treating area
  - b. Dispose of gloves and gauze, paper towels, etc. in trash can
  - c. Wash hands with soap and water
6. Blood spills/vomit
  - a. Always use disposable gloves
  - b. Pour Clorox solution on spill/vomit
  - c. Wipe up with paper towels and dispose in trash can
  - d. Clean with cleaning solution
  - e. Dispose of gloves in trash can
  - f. Wash hands with soap and water
7. Wash hands frequently to prevent infections
